**NOTIFICATION FOR ADMISSION TO DOCTOR OF PHILOSOPHY (Ph.D.) PROGRAMME
2017-18**

Indian Institute of Dalit Studies (New Category of ICSSR Recognised Institute) invites application for admission to Doctor of Philosophy (Ph.D.) Programme (direct) for the session 2017-18. The Institute is affiliated to Indira Gandhi National Tribal University, Amarkantak (Central University), for award of the Ph.D. degree. The Ph.D. programme is interdisciplinary in nature. Students from Economics, Sociology, Anthropology, History, Geography, Social Work, Political Science, Legal Studies, Arts and Literature; and allied disciplines are eligible to apply.

The Institute offers Ph.D. programme on the following themes.

- Inter-personal and group inequalities in social, political and economic spheres with focus on dalits, tribes, religious minorities, women of specific identities like caste, tribe and ethnicity; and similar marginalized groups;
- General and group specific causes of inter-personal and group inequalities;
- Role of exclusion and discrimination in group inequalities in access to income earning assets, poverty, social and political development in housing, health, education, participation in governance and institutions;
- General and group specific policies to address inequalities;
- Social movement related to inequalities, poverty and marginalization among the dalits, tribes religious minorities and women from marginalized groups;
- Issues of social exclusion, discrimination and marginalization in relevant areas.

The course includes both theoretical and empirical research on India and other country experiences on group inequalities and policies.

Eligibility Criteria: Applicants should fulfill the following criteria –

1. M. Phil and/or Research/Academic experience.
2. Post Graduate in Social Sciences or allied fields and Research/Academic experience with NET and eligibility test.

Selection Procedure: Candidates will be selected on the basis of their performance in the Entrance Test comprising of written examination and interview.

Note: Reservation will be given to the SC/ST/OBC/PH candidates, as per the policy of the Government of India. Candidates currently in service are encouraged to apply.

Duration of the Programme : 3 Years
